

# **Home Learning (Homework) Policy**

#### At Aubin Grove Primary School we agree:

- · Homework will be set and marked for all students.
- Homework will directly relate to the age and needs of the student and teaching and learning programs.





# **Our Beliefs**

#### We believe that homework:

- Strengthens the partnership between home and school.
- Assists in keeping parents informed about the student's learning program and their progress at school.
- Is more than academic learning. Homework should be beyond the classroom and support students acquiring important life skills.
- Should not overly impact on time for family, recreational and cultural pursuits.
- Completion may be negotiated with the teacher by the parents, in certain circumstances.
- Should be disassociated from any form of punishing students or to secure discipline.

# **Guidelines**

#### Homework is:

- The responsibility of the classroom teachers to set and mark homework and to notify parents of students who consistently fail to complete the homework.
- The responsibility of the parent to determine the consequences for their own children who fail to complete homework consistently.
- Structured using Homework Grids from Year One to Year Six that are common within each year level.
- Differentiated according to year level and student ability
- \*\*Please note the commencement of the Home Learning Program, including the home reading program for Kindergarten & Pre-primary, is at the discretion of the K/PP collaborative teams.





# **Homework Grid Structure**

The duration of the Homework Grid should carry over two weeks but can be reduced to one week's duration in Year's 5 and 6.

#### Homework Grids should contain a selection of activities that may include:

- Academic tasks
- The Arts
- Sporting or recreational pursuits
- Home duties
- Tasks incorporating the FiSH Philosophy (such as a time when you've been there for someone, or made someone's day).
- Other (such as learning a skill or teaching someone else a new skill).
